The MI Kids Back on Track grant funds (MCL388.1623g) are designed to address unfinished learning, get students to grade-level academic standards, provide additional academic assistance to students at risk of falling behind their peers, or help high school students prepare for postsecondary education.

Funds are meant to address unfinished learning among students and support programs provided before school, during school, after school, or during the summer.

Romeo will use the 23g funds to pay the salary and benefits of our 5 elementary math interventionists to work with targeted, small groups of K-5 students during the school day. The students will be identified through data analysis as at-risk of being behind in the area of mathematics.

Students are selected to receive support from an interventionist after review of several data points by teachers, administrators, and interventionists.
