

TOO SICK FOR SCHOOL?

HERE'S HOW TO TELL



STAY HOME IF ...

- Your child feels too sick for regular activities
- Yellow or green eye discharge appears
- The temperature reads 100.4F or higher on an oral thermometer
- You suspect the flu-symptoms develop quickly
- Your child scratches excessively-and live lice are found
- Body rash with itching and with or without fever
- You suspect or doctor diagnosis strep throat
- Your child is vomiting or has uncontrolled diarrhea or stomach pain



GO BACK TO SCHOOL AFTER ...

- Fever is gone for 24 hours without meds & your child can resume normal activities
- 24 hours after the first dose of antibiotic eye drops & no eye discharge
- No fever above 100.4F without using fever-reducing medications for 24 hours
- Fever free for 24hrs & cough has improved
- When student has been treated & free of live lice and nits
- 24 hours after start of medication or doctor gives the ok to return
- 24 hours after beginning antibiotics
- 24 hours of no vomiting or diarrhea without medication
