

## Elementary - Intra-District Schools of Choice Transfer Request Process (K-5) Guidelines and Procedures 2023-2024

The Romeo Community Schools Board of Education is reinstating the Elementary Intra-District Schools of Choice (K-5) process for the 2023-24 school year. This provides for transfer requests between elementary buildings on a limited basis considering grade level capacity, rationale/reason, available space and contractual class size limits.

INITIAL APPLICATION PERIOD MONDAY, 3/13/2023 - FRIDAY, 5/12/2023 ADDITIONAL APPLICATION PERIOD MONDAY, 7/31/2023 - FRIDAY, 8/11/2023

\*The deadline for application must be met as there will be no exceptions.

Romeo Community Schools families will be able to submit a Schools of Choice Intra-District Transfer Request to attend at an elementary building outside of their current residential attendance area. Current Romeo Community Schools students in grades K-5 have the option to apply for a transfer to another elementary building within the district for the 2023-2024 school year. This application process is intended to allow parents the opportunity to share necessary information that would support their request or rationale (all information will remain confidential). The Superintendent may grant approval of the transfer based on need, capacity-classroom size and availability. Transfer requests should be focused on meeting the unique needs of the student(s).

#### Preference will be given to:

- 1. Currently enrolled students that are moving out of the attendance boundary but not out of the district.
- 2. Siblings of current elementary students that have been previously approved.
- 3. Families providing a purchase agreement indicating a move into a different attendance boundary.
- 4. Other unique circumstances including childcare, medical needs, etc. **may** be approved.

Available seats will be unique to each building and grade level. Current grade level enrollment (average class size rates) will be examined prior to each application period to determine capacity. Available seats in building and grade level **DOES NOT** guarantee approval.

Applicants applying within the initial time frame will be notified of acceptance/denial no later than Friday, 5/19/2023. Denied applications from the initial application period will be considered first during the additional application period. Applicants during the additional application period will be notified of acceptance/denial no later than Friday, 8/18/2023.

District transportation services **will not be** provided for approved transfers through this application process. Applications turned in after the deadline will not be considered. Approved Schools of Choice Intra-District transfer applicants need never re-apply unless the student leaves the district.

\*\* All applications must be accompanied by student's discipline report for the previous 2 school years (even if no discipline was recorded) obtained from the school(s) the student attended during these times. Application must also be accompanied by student's report card/transcript and a copy of their 504 or IEP if applicable. Incomplete forms will be returned and may delay acceptance until all information is provided. \*\*

Out of District (105 and 105C) applicants need never re-apply unless student leaves the district. Non-Resident Children of Employees, once accepted, need never re-apply unless employee is no longer employed in the district. If you move, please contact the Enrollment Center to change your address.

Currently enrolled students that will be in 12<sup>th</sup> grade for the 2023-24 school year and are moving out of district may be able to apply and attend for the purposes of completing their senior year. Please contact the Enrollment Center for more information.

You will be notified via email, phone or regular mail no later than August 25, 2023 if accepted for the 2023-2024 school year. Notification of approval for all incoming Schools of Choice students may be deferred until resident student enrollments are complete.
