**Sinking Fund and Non-Homestead Operating Millage Renewals:**

We are less than two weeks away from the February 27th Election. Our community has the opportunity to make a decision regarding the future of two important ballot proposals; the renewal of our Sinking Fund and Non-Homestead Operating millages. These renewals provide critical funding that helps improve our school facilities and educational programming, along with ensuring a safe and conducive learning environment for our students.
