- Levy of 1.2455 Mills will generate \$3,605,950

Legislative Proposals-Per Pupil Foundation Allowance

- Governor's Budget \$392, 4.1% increase, \$10,000 per pupil
- **Senate's Budget \$400**, 4.6% increase, \$10,008 per pupil
- House Budget \$417, 4.3% increase, \$10,025 per pupil

- Governor's Budget
 - \$392 Per Pupil Increase, Foundation Allowance \$10,000
 - 147a(4) MPSERS Cost Offset-Reduce UAAL
 - 2024-2025 Received Revenue to Offset Pension UAAL \$1,971,227 to Effectively Reduce the Retirement Rate by 5.75%
 - 2025-2026 No Offset Revenue, Retirement Rate Reduction of 5.75%, however, Pension and OPEB Normal Rates Increased Reducing the Retirement Savings, yet District has Lost the Offset Revenue
 - Estimated Increased Retirement Costs \$1,171,626, or \$388 per pupil

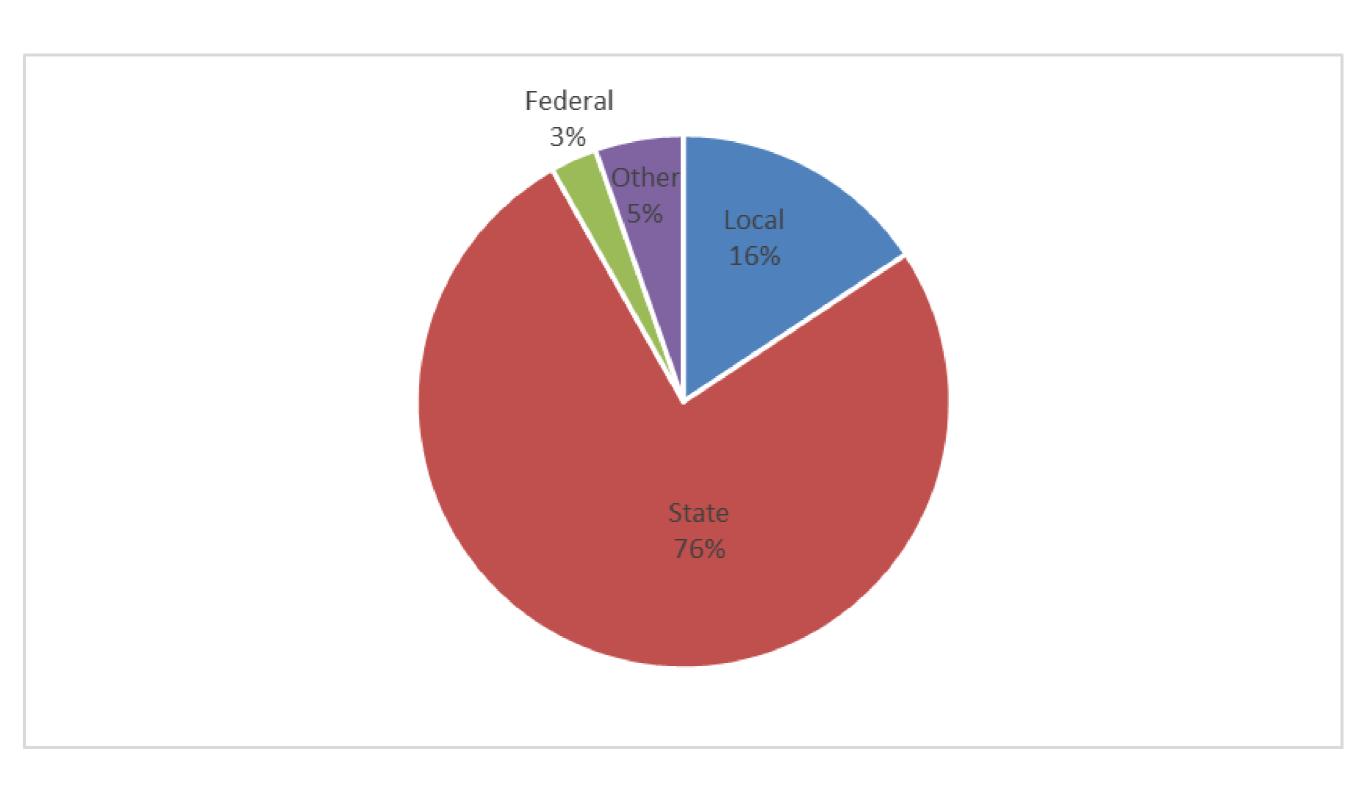

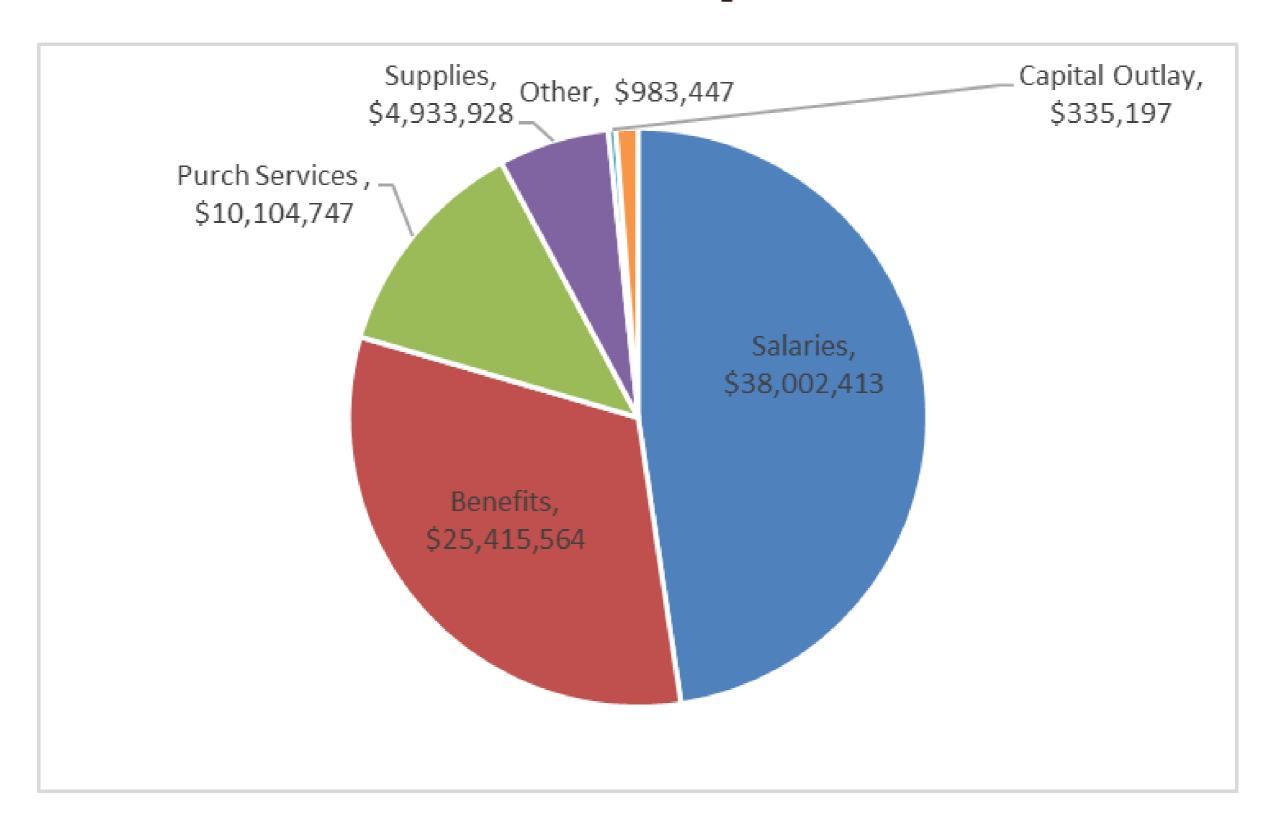
2025-2026 Revenue Sources
