The General Fund Budget was presented along with the fund equity balance estimate for June 30, 2023.

Discussions took place on teacher labs, professional learning and exploring new opportunities for kids. Updates were received on the RVA and the behavioral threat assessment processes.

Facilities – Mr. Antoine gave an overview of the meeting. Bond evaluations for a bid were reviewed. They received a report from Mr. Nelson regarding new AV equipment and discussed the two-way radio project. Replacement of some aging snow equipment was discussed.

Finance – Ms. Barrows stated they had a presentation from Gallagher Benefit Services to review health benefits which are offered to employees due to a large increase in costs for staff members. Also discussed was RASPA wages, 297 Prospect property and general budget conversations (which were covered in the budget presentation).
