

Viewing Standards Progress in Parent Portal

Our elementary students are working to gain mastery in essential grade level standards in all subject areas. The student report card, which is given out at the end of each trimester in December, March, and June, will report on student progress in the standards, and parents can also track their student's progress between report cards electronically via the Parent Portal.

To view your student's standards progress, simply login to your Parent Portal account and click on the "Standards Grades" tab (shown below). Your student's current performance level in each standard will be shown next to the name of the standard.
