

Schools of Choice Guidelines and Procedures 2025-2026

Romeo Community Schools is accepting a limited number of applications for grades 9th - 11th.

9th grade/Class of 2029: 40 seats 10th grade/Class of 2028: 20 seats 11th grade/Class of 2027: 10 seats

These seats are for in person education.

Potential Romeo Virtual Academy students, refer to the Unlimited SOC process.

Application forms will be available online at www.romeok12.org/enrollment beginning Monday, March 17, 2025.

Turn in completed application packets to the Administration Building,or by fax(586-752-0227), or by email (enrollment@romeok12.org).

Please be certain that the documents you forward are legible and clear.

Application packets will be accepted no later than 4:00pm on the closing date of the application period.

All applications must be accompanied by the student's discipline report for the previous two school years (even if no discipline was recorded). You must complete the RCS Affirmation of Discipline form (included under the SOC heading found in the Enrollment section of romeok12.org) and have it completed by the school the student currently attends.

All applications must also be accompanied by the student's most recent *report card* (from 8th grade), or, *transcript* (9th-10th grade) and a copy of their *504 or IEP*, if applicable.

**Incomplete application packets will not be considered and will be returned.

A separate application must be turned in for each student applying**

If there are more applications received than the number of open seats, a lottery will be held. Notification of status, approval or denial, and/or the need for a lottery will be communicated to all parents/guardians of applicants by *April 25, 2025*. Please note that after you receive acceptance notification, further enrollment action must take place in order for the student to attend school. If you are granted one of the seats, the entire enrollment process must be completed on or before *July 7, 2025* or you forfeit the seat and it may be offered to another applicant. Review of enrollees, applicants and available open seats will take place on *July 11, 2025*. All communications regarding these applications will take place no later than *August 25, 2025*.

Current Romeo students that will be in 12th grade for the 2025-2026 school year and are moving outside of the District boundary may be able to apply to remain a student for the purposes of completing their senior year. For more information, please contact the Enrollment Center.

For all 10th - 12th grade Schools of Choice students, in accordance with the rules of the Michigan High School Athletic Association, sports played in the previous school year determines eligibility in 2025-2026. Should the student transfer and not meet one of the 15 stated exceptions, eligibility to play may be in question. Contact the Athletic Department for more information.

Out of District (105 and 105C) students are not eligible for transportation services.

Out of District (105 and 105C) students, once accepted, need never re-apply unless the student breaks enrollment and begins attending elsewhere.
