***9th grade/Class of 2028: 40 seats***

***10th grade/Class of 2027: 20 seats***

***11th grade/Class of 2026: 20 seats***

These seats are for in person education. Potential Romeo Virtual Academy students, use the unlimited SOC application form.

**Application Period**

April 10, 2024 - May 9, 2024

A separate application is needed for *each* student.

Completed application packets will be accepted at the administration building,  
by fax( 586-752-0227) or by email ([enrollment@romeok12.org](mailto:enrollment@romeok12.org)).

Application packets will be accepted no later than 4:00pm on the  
closing date of the application period.

**All applications must be accompanied by the student's discipline report for the previous 2 school years (even if no discipline was recorded).**

**All applications must also be accompanied by the student's most recent report card (1st-9th grades), or, transcript (10th-11th grades) and a copy of their 504 or IEP, if applicable.**

**Young 5 and Kindergarten applicants need not supply discipline and grade reports.**

**\*\*Incomplete application packets will not be consider and will be returned.  
Once complete, please resubmit.\*\***

In the event that there are more applications received than the number of open seats, a lottery will be held. Notification of status, approval or denial, and/or the need for a lottery will be communicated to all parents/guardians of applicants by *Friday, May 24th*. Please note that after you receive acceptance notification, further enrollment action must take place in order for the student to attend school. If you are granted one of the seats, the entire enrollment process must be completed on or before *Monday, August 5th* or you forfeit the seat and it may be offered to another applicant. Review of enrollees, applicants and available open seats will take place on August 12th.

All communications regarding these applications will take place no later than August 29, 2024.\*

Current Romeo students that will be in 12<sup>th</sup> grade for the 2024-25 school year and are moving out of the District may be able to apply to remain a student for the purposes of completing their senior year. For more information, please contact the Enrollment Center.

For all 10th - 12th grade Schools of Choice students, in accordance with the rules of the Michigan High School Athletic Association, sports played in the previous school year determines eligibility in 2024-2025. Should the student transfer and not meet one of the 15 stated exceptions, eligibility to play may be in question. Contact the Athletic Department for more information.

Out of District (105 and 105C) students are not eligible for transportation services.

Out of District (105 and 105C) students, once accepted, need never re-apply unless the student breaks enrollment and begins attending elsewhere.

Non-Resident Children of Employees, once accepted, need never re-apply unless the employee is not longer employed by the District.
