

RHS Senior Year College Timeline

**For those planning to attend college, below is a timeline of what needs to be done*

Be sure you have reviewed and followed the recommendations in the following two important documents:

Anytime

- Explore Xello, [Big Future](#), and college websites
- Schedule campus visits through college websites
- Visit with the college admissions representatives who visit RHS in the fall
- Attend virtual or live [college fairs](#)
- Regularly browse the posted [Non-Local Scholarships](#) and any other scholarships

August - November 1

- Submit your college applications online
- Send transcripts to colleges through your [Parchment](#) account
- Ask EARLY if you need a teacher to complete a recommendation on Common App

December 1 - May 1

- Complete your [FAFSA](#) to apply for financial aid (the earlier the better)
- May 1 is the Michigan FAFSA deadline, but check with each college.

December - March

- Check out the RHS Local Scholarships

May 1

- Make sure to notify your colleges if you will be accepting or declining your admission by May 1

June

- Request to send your final transcript through your [Parchment](#) account to the college you plan to attend.
