

## Referral Process for Intensive Resource Room

- 1. Complete Referral Packet. Please include the following:
  - Current MET/REED
  - Current MET/REED Reports
  - Current IEP
  - Current Report Card / Progress Report
  - Update/progress report of any related services
  - Strategy Planning Form
  - Skills Checklist
  - Communication Questionnaire
  - BIP/FBA (if applicable)
- 2. Send complete packet to Special Services for review by the Director.
  - 3. Packet will be sent from Special Services to the Review Team for consideration. (Members of the review team will be the IRR Teacher; School Psychologist; School Social Worker; Speech and Language Pathologist)
  - 4. As part of this review, an observation by the IRR Teacher will be scheduled to assess student functioning in their current classroom environment.
  - 5. After the observation is complete, the IRR Teacher and/or other member of the review team will meet with the home school team to discuss findings.
  - 6. If referral is appropriate, the home schoo\_I team will notify the student's parents/family of the change in placement. The home school team will schedule the IEP.
- 7. If the student does not meet the criteria for an IRR placement; the lead teacher (in IRR classroom) may assist the home school team with strategies and consult as needed.
